Agriculture Activities at HOPE VILLAGE

In 2012 a committee was formed to address the needs of farming projects. The committee as a group has responsibility for the overall efforts required to make the farm productive and move new plans along. As individuals, each member has responsibility for one area of production - rubber trees, palm oil and crops. Egg production and pig farming was also added in the fall of 2012 as soon as adequate pens and shelters could be constructed to protect the livestock. The first litter of pigs occurred in April of 2013.

Another Rapid City charity, Help Orphans and Widows Inc., recently donated \$2,000 to purchase goats that will provide milk and eventually meat to those residing at Hope Village. The plan is to provide housing to a widow or widows who will care for the goats and also several orphans. Too often widows and orphans subsist on too little.

The original plans for Hope Village called for a 12 room school & auditorium to be surrounded by 8 "pods" of 5 orphan homes each that also included an outdoor kitchen in the midst of the 5 homes. At present the



school has expanded to 14 rooms and 10 of the planned 40 homes are in place. Fund raising efforts of friends over the past year total \$10,000 - enough to build a third "pod" of 5 homes. Ground breaking is planned after the first of the year!
